#### **ORIGINS AND TRADITION**


In June 1961, 50 area residents with a passion for the stage met at the Chandler Memorial Library to found the Nashua Theatre Guild. NTG produced its first show, *Strange Bedfellows*, in February 1962. Through the decades, NTG's mission has remained the



same—To present quality live theatre for the enjoyment and enrichment of residents of Nashua and the surrounding communities.

#### Nashua Theatre Guild Today

Today, Nashua Theatre Guild presents at least five productions each year.



Each summer, NTG, in conjunction with Nashua SummerFun, produces Shakespeare in the Park. Audience members are welcome to attend these critically acclaimed performances in Greeley Park free of charge.

In the fall and spring, NTG's offerings have included far-out farce, daring dramas, cultured comedies, and progressive plays that defy description.

In 2003, NTG began the *Night of New Directors*, a show-case for talented individuals to make their New England directorial debuts.

In addition, NTG consistently participates in the Nashua Downtown Winter Stroll, most recently with readings of *A Child's Christmas in Wales*.

Finally, NTG has been participating in the New Hampshire Community Theatre Association (NHCTA) Festival for two decades, consistently receiving high praise, including the award for Best Show in 1997.
